

GARBAGE, RECYCLE, DISPOSAL of TENANT POSSESSIONS

The goal of the garbage and recycle policy is to promote a healthy and safe environment in and around our building, to minimize costs and to ensure compliance with local bylaws.

All Municipal and CRD bylaws are to be followed.

The Society endeavours to periodically post the guidelines around the disposal of items, but it is ultimately the tenant's responsibility to deal appropriately with disposal of garbage, recycle and unwanted personal items.

Garbage

Bag all acceptable household garbage, using "kitchen catcher size" bags, or if **using plastic "grocery bags"** - please **double bag**.

Recyclables

Recyclables must be clean and acceptable as per CRD guidelines (available by phone or online through the CRD).

Disposal of electronic items is the tenant's responsibility and can be recycled at "Return-it" centers (for locations: www.encorp.ca).

DISPOSAL OF PERSONAL ITEMS

Disposal of all unwanted personal possessions is the **Tenant's responsibility**.

Dumping of these items in or around the common areas or garbage bins is not acceptable, and the tenant will be charged for disposal.

Failure to comply with this policy will be considered a material breach of the tenancy.
