

TENANT GARDENING

The Greater Victoria Housing Society encourages tenants to become involved in gardening at the buildings where there is space set aside for tenant gardening. Tenants may want to set up a gardening committee to organize the activities of the gardeners.

A small amount of money to cover incidentals and planting of annual flowers is available. Requests for funding must be made in writing, with a description of intended purchases. Once approval is received, the tenant will be reimbursed when a receipt for the purchases are presented to the Society.

The Society will not mediate disputes between gardening volunteers. Any problems with volunteer gardening may result in the privilege being revoked.

Volunteers participating in the gardening and landscaping will accept direction from the Society as to the scope and level of gardening that will be done. Gardening by the tenants is confined to the areas designated by the Society.

Any changes to the building's existing landscaping must be approved in writing by the Society. Making changes to the property without written permission is a breach of a material term of the tenancy. The tenant will be held responsible for any cost incurred required to reverse any unauthorized changes

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
