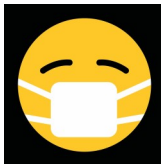

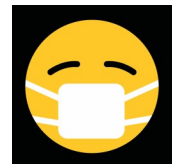

☆ We have decided to close the common rooms in all of our buildings until further notice due to increased COVID risk on the island. Thank you for understanding.
